During its November 2022 meeting, the CHMP reviewed 1 recommendation for eligibility to PRIME which was denied. The outcome adopted this month is listed below.

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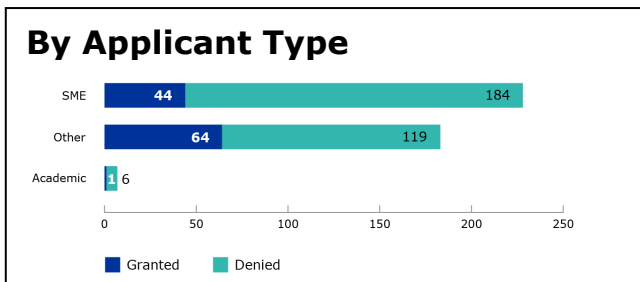
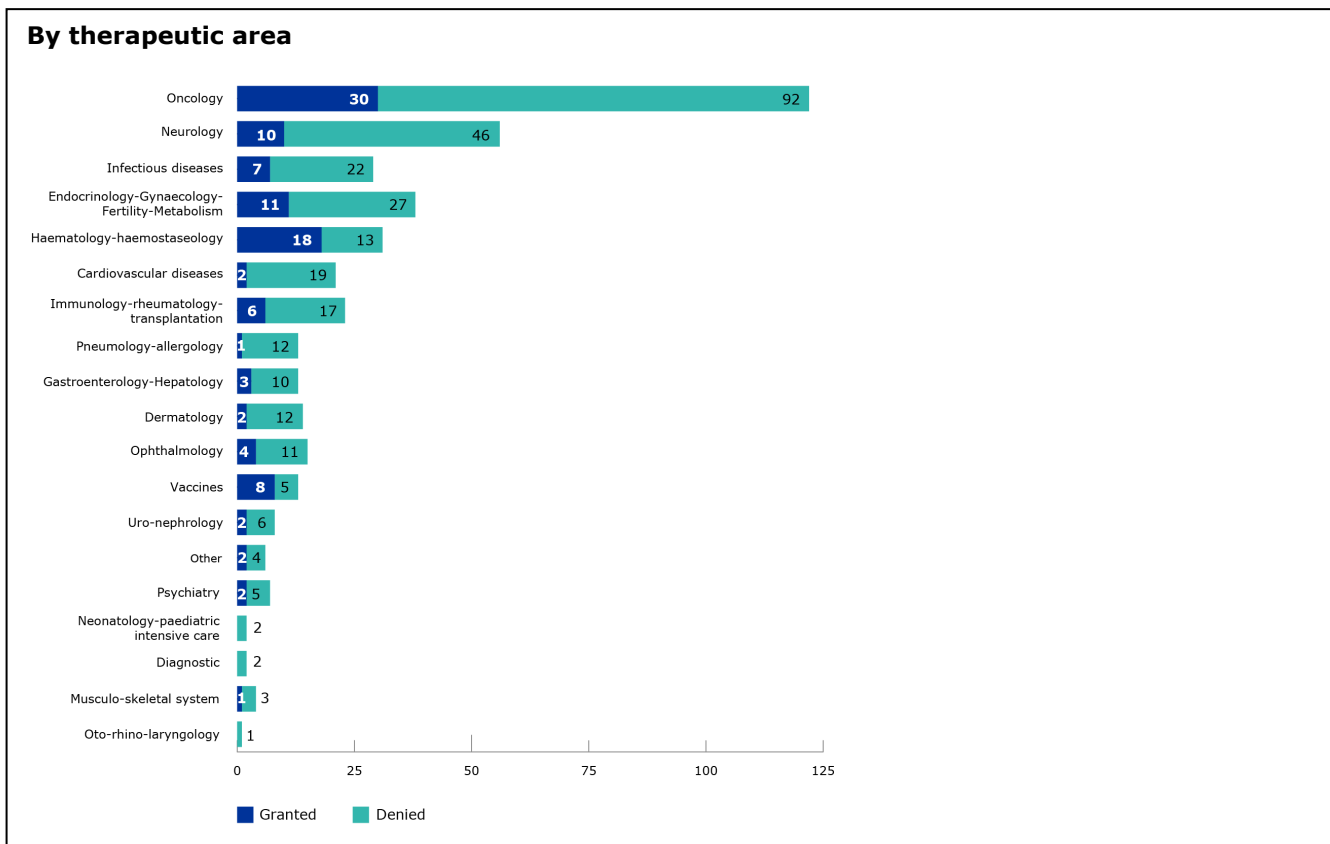
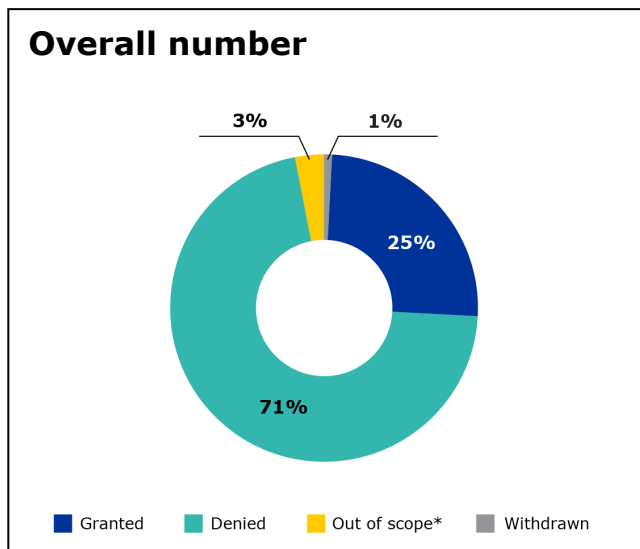
Eligibility denied

SME applicants are micro-, small-and medium-sized-enterprises registered with the Agency's SME office. Other type of applicants are those not qualifying or not registered as SME or not fulfilling the definition of academic sponsors.
