Opinion of the HMPC on a European Union herbal monograph on *Carum carvi* L., aetheroleum

Opinion

The HMPC, in accordance with Article 16h(3) of Directive 2001/83/EC, as amended, and as set out in the appended assessment report, establishes by a majority of 27 out of 28 votes a European Union herbal monograph on *Carum carvi* L., aetheroleum which is set out in Annex I.

The divergent position is appended to this opinion.

The Norwegian HMPC member agrees with the above-mentioned recommendation of the HMPC.

This opinion is forwarded to Member States, to Iceland and Norway, together with its Annex I and appendices.

Regarding the European Union herbal monograph for *Carum carvi* L., aetheroleum, I do not support the proposed <u>cutaneous use</u> in infants, children, adolescents, adults and elderly, in relation to the indication: Traditional herbal medicinal product for the symptomatic relief of digestive disorders such as bloating and flatulence, because of the pharmacological effects are not sufficiently made plausible based on long-term marketing and experience.
