Background

The emergence and increase of microbes resistant to antimicrobial treatments is a global public health concern that poses a risk to the effective treatment of infectious diseases. Combatting this threat, particularly resistance to antibiotics, is a high priority for the European Medicines Agency (EMA) and the European medicines regulatory network.

Responding to a high interest from PCWP and HCPWP, EMA joined efforts with the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) to prepare and informative session intended to raise awareness of ongoing initiatives and stimulate an exchange of ideas with patient, consumer and healthcare professional organisations on how to join efforts for improving communication, education and training.

Objectives

- 1. Raise awareness of the work of EU Institutions, member states and WHO in the fight against AMR.
- 2. Enhance understanding of how EMA and ECDC can support the European and global-level fight against AMR.
- 3. Discuss how to coordinate efforts on awareness and empowerment by patients, consumers and healthcare professionals.
