Background and objectives

On 15 December 2015 the Commission Regulation (EC) No 2049/2005 (SME Regulation) reaches a 10-year anniversary milestone. To mark the occasion, the European Medicine Agency's SME Office is hosting this roundtable meeting with stakeholders.

By Underground

The nearest stop for Churchill Place is Canary Wharf station on the Jubilee Line. From East exit (NB. This is the closest exit to 30 Churchill Place): exit the station and turn left into Upper Bank Street, turn right at Canada Square and continue straight into Churchill Place.

By Docklands Light Railway (DLR)


