# HMPC meeting report on European Union herbal monographs, guidelines and other activities

The 66<sup>th</sup> HMPC meeting, held on 28-29 September 2015

The Chair of the Committee on Herbal Medicinal Products (HMPC) welcomed all delegates and experts to the 66<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Committee including Una Mockler now as member and Annamarie O'Sullivan as new alternate for Ireland. The renunciation of Artūras Kažemekaitis (awaiting new member nomination from Lithuania) was announced.

# Final European Union herbal monographs

Upon recommendation from the MLWP, the HMPC adopted the following final EU herbal monographs and supporting documents:

- European Union herbal monograph on Myrtilli fructus recens, by majority vote
- European Union herbal monograph on Myrtilli fructus siccus, by majority vote

#### Revised European Union herbal monographs

Upon recommendation from the MLWP the HMPC adopted the following draft revised EU herbal monograph and supporting documents for 3 months public consultation until **31 January 2016**:

European Union herbal monograph on Pelargonii radix

The review had been triggered by new scientific data available to the HMPC (re-evaluation of the Validity of the Bronchitis Severity Scale BSS, see meeting report May 2013 EMA/HMPC/301544/2013). Although no major changes were introduced in the monograph, a public consultation was considered useful after careful new assessment of scientific data as reflected in the revised assessment report. Interested parties are given the opportunity to comment before finalisation of the revision.

#### Prioritisation of new substances for assessment and call for scientific data

Upon recommendation by the MLWP the Committee agreed to the assessment of

- Vaccinium macrocarpon, fructus
- Malva sylvestris, flos
- Malva sylvestris, folium

Calls for submission of scientific data with a deadline for submission by **31 January 2016** will be initiated to support the first assessment.

The HMPC agreed to the requests based on preliminary information from NCAs on the likelihood to establish 15/30 years long-standing safe medicinal use for a harmonised European opinion on safety and efficacy. The MLWP was asked to assign Rapporteur and Peer reviewer.

#### Cancellation of assessment work

Upon recommendation by the MLWP the Committee agreed not to issue a call for scientific data and to discontinue the assessment work for

Cinnamomi camphorae cortex / folium/ aetheroleum

Following a request for information on products on the market among National Competent Authorities, the Rapporteur considered available data on the traditional use as insufficient with reference to identification of combination products only, mainly with synthetic camphor, as well as difficulties to distinguish between synthetic and natural camphor.

## Prioritisation of substances for monograph systematic review and revision

The HMPC confirmed the need to keep monographs as up-to-date EU standard for national procedures. In view of limited resources and the back-log with the systematic review of monographs after 5 years, the Committee agreed to a proposal by the Monograph and List Working Party to prioritise 35 substances for systematic review. The MLWP work plan 2016 will be drafted accordingly.

# **Drafting Group on Quality (DG Q)**

The HMPC heard a report on the DG Q meeting held on 10 September 2015.

The DG discussed the follow-up on the reflection paper on microbiological aspects (EMA/HMPC/95714/2013) and draft Q&A in this regard. Because of detailed discussions expected during the HMPC assessors training in December finalisation of the Q&A is only expected in February 2016. The revision 3 of the Guideline on quality of herbal medicinal products/traditional herbal medicinal products was started. DG Q had further discussed the preparation of the 2015 HMPC assessors training on quality as well as status of work 2015 and a first draft of the work plan 2016.

The next meeting of the DG Q will be held on 15 October 2015.

### **Drafting Group on Organisational matters (DG ORGAM)**

The meeting of the DG ORGAM scheduled for 8 September 2015 had been cancelled.

The next meeting of the DG ORGAM is scheduled for 13 October 2015.

# Report from the September 2015 meeting of the Working Party on European Union Monographs and List (MLWP)

The MLWP held its 57<sup>th</sup> meeting at the European Medicines Agency on 29 September–01 October 2015.

#### Monograph revisions

The working party discussed and endorsed the revised documents on Hederae helicis folium after public consultation for peer review and transfer to the Committee for final adoption as well as the draft revised documents on Althaeae radix for possible public consultation in November 2015.

The MLWP further discussed revised documents on Salviae officinalis folium, Salviae officinalis aetheroleum, Aloe, Harpagophyti radix, Sennae folium and Sennae fructus.

#### Monograph finalisation

Upon request by the HMPC, the working party re-discussed and finalised the documents on Sabalis serrulatae fructus for possible final adoption at the HMPC November 2015 meeting.

Following public consultation, the MLWP discussed and endorsed the documents on Crataegi folium cum flore, Epilobii herba and Uncariae tomentosae cortex for peer review and transfer to the Committee for possible final adoption in November 2015.

#### Monograph drafts

The MLWP discussed and endorsed the draft documents on Balsamum peruvianum, Pruni africanae cortex and Cisti cretici folium for transfer to the HMPC for possible release in November 2015 for public consultation.

The working party continued its assessment of Fragariae folium and had a first discussion on the assessment of Saccharomyces cerevisiae/S. boulardii.

The next meeting of the MLWP is scheduled for 24-26 November 2015.
