Opinion

The HMPC, in accordance with Article 16h(3) of Directive 2001/83/EC and as set out in the appended assessment report, establishes by a majority of 25 out of 26 votes a revised European Union herbal monograph on *Eucalyptus globulus* Labill.; *Eucalyptus polybractea* R.T. Baker; *Eucalyptus smithii* R.T. Baker, aetheroleum which is set out in Annex I.

The divergent position is appended to this opinion.

The Norwegian HMPC member agrees with the above-mentioned recommendation of the HMPC.

This opinion is forwarded to Member States and Norway, together with its Annex I and appendices.

The revised European Union herbal monograph and assessment report will be published on the European Medicines Agency website. They replace those adopted on 25 March 2014.
