Opinion

The HMPC, in accordance with Article 16h(3) of Directive 2001/83/EC, as amended, and as set out in the appended assessment report, establishes by a majority of 28 out of 29 votes a European Union herbal monograph on *Betula pendula* Roth, *Betula pubescens* Ehrh. as well as hybrids of both species, folium which is set out in Annex I.

The Norwegian HMPC member agrees with the above-mentioned recommendation of the HMPC.

This opinion is forwarded to Member States, to Iceland and Norway, together with its Annex I and appendix.

The European Union herbal monograph and assessment report will be published on the European Medicines Agency website. They replace those added on 8 May 2008.

The product is a traditional herbal medicinal product for use in the specified indication exclusively based upon long-standing use"
