RECOMMENDATION FOR THE INCLUSION IN ANNEX II OF COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 2377/90 OF

ANY SUBSTANCE USED IN VETERINARY HOMEOPATHIC MEDICINAL PRODUCTS PROVIDED THAT ITS CONCENTRATION IN THE PRODUCT DO NOT EXCEED ONE PART PER TEN THOUSAND

1. Considering that for all substance used in veterinary homeopathic medicinal products at concentrations not exceeding one part per ten thousand, the safety of consumers would not be put at risk should these substances be introduced in Annex II of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2377/90;
2. The Committee for Veterinary Medicinal Products recommends that all substances used in veterinary homeopathic medicinal products, provided that their concentration in the product do not exceed one part per ten thousand, should be added to the substances listed in Annex II of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2377/90.
