MRL summary opinion¹

Paromomycin

Poultry eggs

On 15 February 2018, the Committee for Medicinal Products for Veterinary Use (CVMP) adopted an opinion² recommending the establishment of a maximum residue limit for paromomycin in chicken eggs. Furthermore, and with reference to Article 5 of Regulation (EC) No 470/2009, the Committee agreed to extrapolate the maximum residue limit recommended in chicken eggs to eggs of other poultry species, in accordance with the following table:
