Exemption for nationals of the accession country (Croatia)

THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

HAVING REGARD to Articles 27, 28 and 29 of the Staff Regulations,

HAVING REGARD to Article 1 of the Executive Director Decision laying down rules on the secondment of national experts to the Agency,

HAVING REGARD to Article 2 of the Rules governing the in-service training at the EMA,

HAVING REGARD to the opinion of the Staff Committee,

WHEREAS the Agency must be able to select for recruitment nationals from the accession country in advance of the accession date and to recruit nationals of the new Member State as of its accession date in order to have staff with the necessary skills so that all duties and responsibilities of the Agency can be properly fulfilled,

HAS ADOPTED the following rules:

Article 1 –recruitment processes

Croatian nationals are entitled to apply for the following recruitment processes at the Agency as of 1 January 2013: Temporary Agent selection procedures (all grades), Contract Agents selection procedures (all function groups), Traineeship programme starting on 1 October 2013, Interims, National Experts on Secondment, Visiting Experts. Croatian nationals can be on a reserve list or being considered for recruitment prior to the accession date 1 July 2013.

Article 2 –appointments

Croatian nationals may only be appointed to a position at the Agency as of the accession date 1 July 2013.

Article 3 –effective date

These rules take effect on 1 November 2012 and expire on 31 December 2018.
