Use medicines correctly. Help protect your animal and keep parasite treatments effective for the future.

WHEN PARASITE TREATMENTS DON'T WORK

Parasite medicines should protect your animal.

If they don't, something may be wrong. **Watch for:**

- parasites still present;
- no improvement after treatment;
- ongoing itching, weight loss or poor growth.

✔ **Talk to your vet.**

HELP KEEP TREATMENTS WORKING

Parasites can become harder to treat if medicines are:

- used too often or when not needed;
- given at the wrong dose;
- not used as instructed.

✔ **Always follow your vet's advice.**

✔ **Use the correct dose.**

✔ **Follow the package instructions.**

SPEAK UP. IT MAKES A DIFFERENCE

Reporting treatment problems helps:

- detect resistance early;
- protect animal health;
- keep medicines effective for the future.

✔ **If you're unsure, ask your vet.**

✔ **Your action helps protect all animals.**
