your oversight
protects animal and
public health.



Veterinarians, swipe to
find out how you can help.



Treat only if necessary.
Balance the **benefits**
and risks for:

- the animal;
- humans exposed;
- the environment.



Before **treating or prescribing**:

- confirm parasite presence or risk;
- assess parasite burden via testing.



Only use **combination products** when:

- there is a mixed infection/infestation or risk;
- use aligns strictly with the indications in the product information.



Accurate **dosing** is **critical**.

- ✓ When possible weigh animals before treatment.
- ✓ Use the appropriate dosing device.
- ✓ Avoid under and overdosing.



Educate **animal owners and farmers** on:

- correct administration;
- appropriate dose;
- treatment intervals;
- completing the treatment;
- monitoring effectiveness.



If you suspect
products aren't
working as expected
or you see adverse
events - **report it.**
