Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 1901/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 December 2006 on medicinal products for paediatric use and amending Regulation (EEC) No. 1768/92, Directive 2001/20/EC, Directive 2001/83/EC and Regulation (EC) No 726/2004¹,

Having regard to Regulation (EC) No 726/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 31 March 2004 laying down Community procedures for the authorisation and supervision of medicinal products for human and veterinary use and establishing a European Medicines Agency²,

Having regard to the application submitted by BeiGene Ireland Limited on 19 April 2021 under Article 13 of Regulation (EC) No 1901/2006,

Having regard to the opinion of the Paediatric Committee of the European Medicines Agency, issued on 23 July 2021 in accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EC) No 1901/2006,

Having regard to Article 25 of Regulation (EC) No 1901/2006,

Whereas:

- (1) The Paediatric Committee has given an opinion on the granting of a product specific waiver.
- (2) It is therefore appropriate to adopt a decision granting a waiver.

Has adopted this decision:

Basis for opinion

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EC) No 1901/2006 as amended, BeiGene Ireland Limited submitted to the European Medicines Agency on 19 April 2021 an application for a product-specific waiver on the grounds set out in Article 11 of said Regulation for the above mentioned medicinal product.

The procedure started on 25 May 2021.

Opinion

1. The Paediatric Committee, having assessed the waiver application in accordance with Article 13 of Regulation (EC) No 1901/2006 as amended, recommends as set out in the appended summary report:
 - to grant a product-specific waiver for all subsets of the paediatric population and all the above mentioned conditions in accordance with Article 11(1)(b) of said Regulation, on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended occurs only in adult populations; Article 11(1)(c) of said Regulation, on the grounds that the specific medicinal product does not represent a significant therapeutic benefit over existing treatments for paediatric patients.

The Norwegian Paediatric Committee member agrees with the above-mentioned recommendation of the Paediatric Committee.

2. The grounds for the granting of the waiver are set out in Annex I.

This opinion is forwarded to the applicant and the Executive Director of the European Medicines Agency, together with its annex and appendix.

Annex I

Grounds for the granting of the waiver

1. Waiver

1.1. Condition:

Treatment of lung cancer

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).

1.2. Condition:

Treatment of breast cancer

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).

1.3. Condition:

Treatment of endometrial carcinoma

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).

1.4. Condition:

Treatment of hepatocellular carcinoma

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the specific medicinal product does not represent a significant therapeutic benefit as clinical studies(s) are not feasible.

1.5. Condition:

Treatment of oesophageal carcinoma

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).

1.6. Condition:

Treatment of gastric and gastroesophageal junction adenocarcinoma

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).

1.7. Condition:

Treatment of head and neck epithelial malignant neoplasms

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).

1.8. Condition:

Treatment of intestinal malignant neoplasms

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).

1.9. Condition:

Treatment of cervical cancer

The waiver applies to:

- all subsets of the paediatric population from birth to less than 18 years of age;
- concentrate for solution for infusion, intravenous use;
- on the grounds that the disease or condition for which the specific medicinal product is intended does not occur in the specified paediatric subset(s).
