A scheduled review of the Phase 3 E.mbrace study conducted by an independent data monitoring committee (IDMC) determined that ExPEC9V was not sufficiently efficacious at preventing invasive E. coli disease (IED) compared to placebo among study participants. No safety signals related to the vaccine were identified. As a result of the IDMC's determination, the E.mbrace study and the ExPEC program are discontinued.
