

SWEDEN - LEGAL BASIS

- transition from monopoly to diversified pharmacy market
- antimicrobials are dispensed by pharmacies
- pharmacies are authorised by MPA
- pharmacies are to report sales of drugs to a state owned "Service company"
- "Service company" is to provide data to, e.g., Board of Agriculture
- Govt decisions
 - Board of Agriculture responsible for animal drug statistics (2005)
 - SVA responsible for surveillance of antimicrobial resistance (1999)
