### **AESGP Mission**

- AESGP welcomes EMEA Homeopathic Workshop
- Harmonisation very important
- Interpretation of CD 2001/83/EC
- Existing products and national traditions



#### **Guidance documents prepared by HMPWG:**

- CTD, Safe dilution
- Very useful to achieve harmonised assessment criteria
- Some open questions and need for improvement e. g. viral safety criteria



#### Manufacturing methods:

- Harmonisation of manufacturing methods difficult
- Very important for mutual recognition
- AESGP welcomes harmonisation, but national traditions and existing products must be respected



#### **Stability:**

- Pragmatic requirements for the submission of stability data (CPMP/QWP/122/02 rev. 1)
- Good approaches already made in Europe
- Guidance on a European level desirable



#### **GMP** requirements for active substances:

- Art. 46 of CD 2001/83/EC: "to use as starting materials only <u>active substances</u> which have been manufactured in accordance ... with GMP ..."
- For most of the starting materials used in homeopathic products, GMP conditions are not feasible



# GMP requirements for active substances (continued):

- Solution proposed: Starting material itself is <u>not</u> a homeopathic active substance until having been processed in accordance with a homeopathic manufacturing procedure
- In line with the principles of homeopathy
- No need to extend the list of "Atypical Actives" by approx. 2000 positions
