 - ❑ Greece has joined the ESVAC network
- ❑ Publication of the ESVAC 7th report – October 2017





Minor adjustments to the 7th ESVAC report

Section “Results” to start with population-corrected sales

- To highlight the main indicator
- To avoid any misinterpretation of what is the focus in the report

Subsection of polymyxins will reflect latest available reference data (2015)

Business Intelligence (interactive database)

- ❑ Interactive database includes now approved data from 2010
- ❑ Links to the latest published report and to the ESVAC web page are available now on the landing page
- ❑ Tab with technical information is added
- ❑ 2015 data will be accessible at the same time when ESVAC 7th report is published on EMA web page



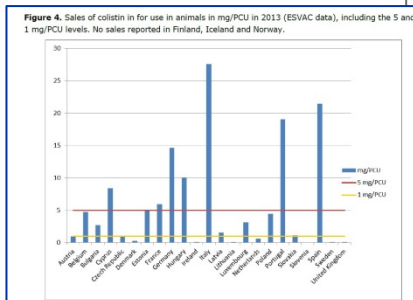

- Providing data for EMA projects: JIACRA II, RONAFA, AMEG (opinion on colistin)



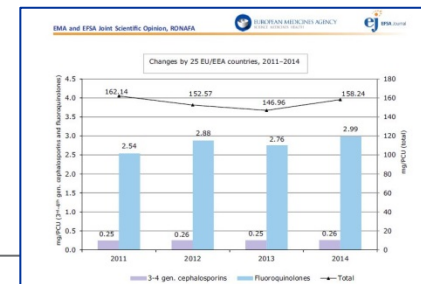
