

# Retrospective Workshops with POs and SMEs



#### Goal:

Conduct a retrospective on the PO, NPO and SME interactions with each other and the Network and Industry communities as this is a core part of EMA's agile governance model.

POs, NPOs and SMEs were invited to provide feedback in a "futurespective" – reasoning from a desired future state back towards what is needed to get there.

#### **Steps in the retrospective:**

- Collect feedback, identify best practices and challenges
- Analyse & refine

# What's working well

# For industry SMEs & their community

- Regular meetings & email exchange with Trade Associations representatives
- Some products' SMEs set up industry support teams of non-SME peers
- At least one product's SMEs have created a charter to establish roles & responsibilities
- Actively working on reviewing and comparing all guidance documents, surveys, KPIs and documents

#### For NCAs POs + SMEs & their community

- Are able to structurally join meetings and contribute
- Are in the process of building networks inside their NCA and with peers
- Share experiences from national systems they are aware of
- Feel they are able to reflect network impacts they are aware of

#### In the **Product teams collaboration** (including SMEs)

- Onboarded their SMEs
- Weekly touch points with follow-up and outcomes shared by email
- SMEs for several products enabled to contribute to testing and piloting of products

#### **Topics raised for improvement**

- Access to system and tools to allow close collaboration on design and testing
- Community connections still developing for some products and lack a forum
- Decision legitimacy concerns regarding ability of SMEs to deliver consensus
- Cross-product visibility & strategic influence for industry
- Time allocation challenging for some SMEs or due to over asking by product team
- Transparency on system issues is a barrier to understanding the system and explaining t to peers
- Selection and onboarding is challenging and not standardised
- Member state initiatives and legal requirements challenging to consider in EMA system development
- Timelines are unclear which results in NCA and Industry's inability to plan and contribute
