



Policy 0070 - Anonymisation Report (AnR) Evolution





AnR Template Content (1/3) – Anonymisation Strategy

Anonymisation approach

Tick boxes (quantitative / qualitative)

Personal data variables – presented in a tabulated manner

- Columns for category of data subject & anonymisation technique
- Fields will contain predefined values (drop-down lists)

No free text box



AnR Template Content (2/3) – Risk Assessment

Description of reference population

- Targeted questions on size and definition of the reference population
- Targeted questions on rare disease and special population categories

Risk assessment

• Initial risk of reidentification, selected risk threshold and residual risk

Free text box

Explain the anonymisation strategy

AnR Template Content (3/3) – Data Utility & Deviations

Data variables bearing the highest data utility

- 5 most important personal data variables
- Extent of the data utility preservation

Aggregated data

- Expected to be disclosed in full
- Blinding redactions to be documented in the deviation section

Narratives

- Expected to be anonymised
- Redaction in full considered a deviation

- ✓ One report for joint EMA/HC packages

Regulators

- ✓ Review efficiency
- ✓ EMA/HC workshare

- Portal Users
- ✓ Concise
- ✓ Easier to understand
- ✓ Facilitates the identification of key information
 - Data utility considerations
 - Data transformations
