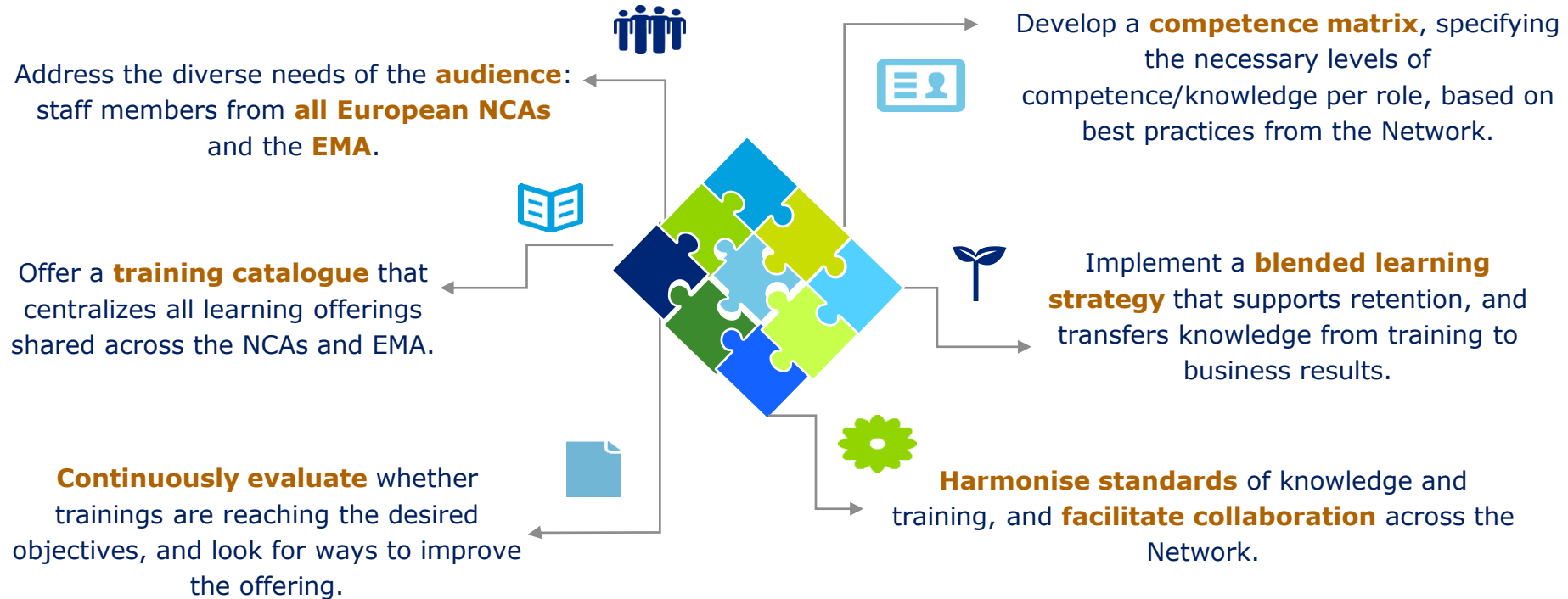

Building EU NTC training catalogue

- First training catalogue for **all network staff**
- **150+** training events
- **22 agencies** contributed by opening up their training



Encouraging and supporting webinars

- A **resource-effective** way of opening local training to the network
- **46 webinars** supported



Launching EU NTC interim platform

- Advertising the **EU NTC catalogue** + information/documents and forms
- **2250 unique visitors** since launch in Feb '15



Reimbursing training participation

- **15 courses** approved for reimbursement by the EU NTC
- **280+ participants** reimbursed for attending

A new milestone for the EU NTC and the network

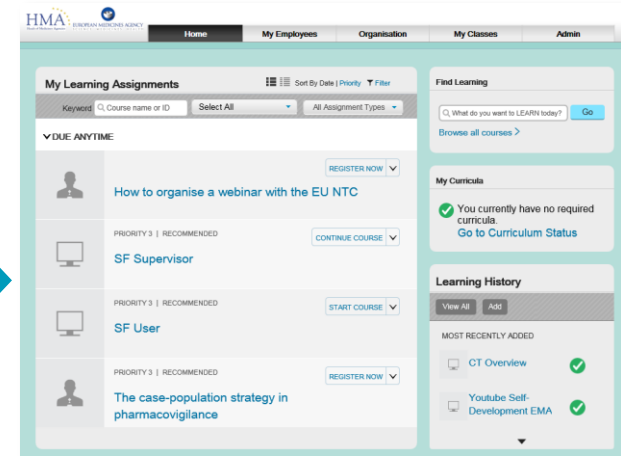
To continue fulfilling its mission in a resource-effective and sustainable way, the EU NTC has launched



Learning Management System (LMS)

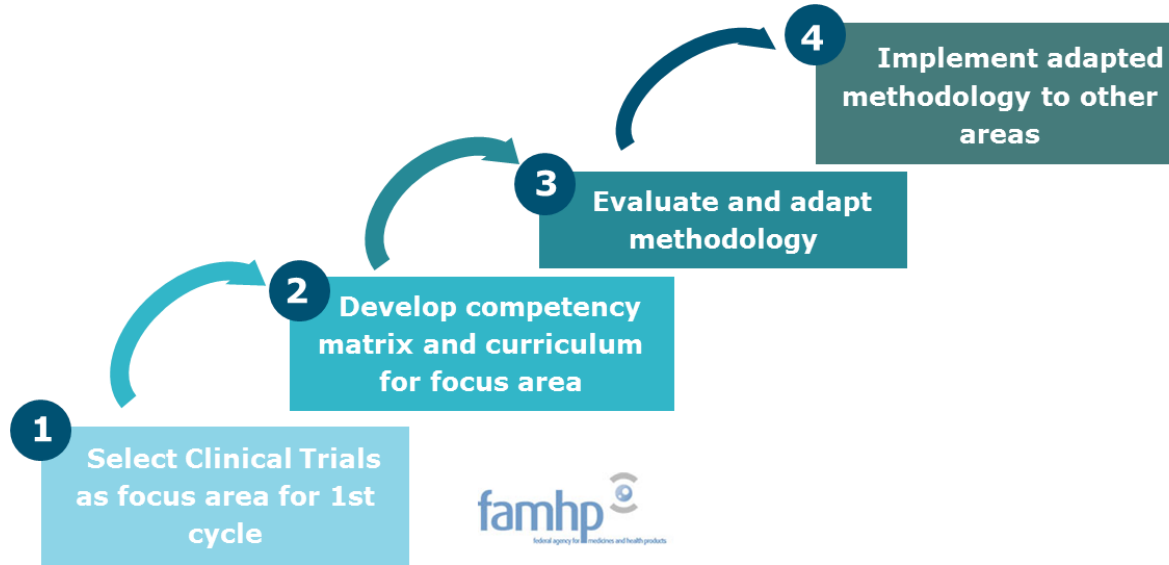


EU NTC Interim platform

Competency matrix and curriculum development



- FAMHP (BE) led the development of competency matrices and curricula in the field of Clinical Trials, where the methodology was tested and agreed, with the support of the EU NTC.
- Next areas for competency and curricula development: Quality, Regulatory Affairs, Paediatrics, Veterinary topics, Pharmacovigilance and ATMPs

Benefits of the Learning Management System

- Easily find, register and track courses through one **user-friendly** central platform
- Ability to offer **feedback** and **recommend** courses
- **Instant access** to qualitative training from across the Network, including online training
- **Knowledge spreading**: easier for agencies to open up courses or share materials with the network
- **Scientific curricula** offered for the different areas of expertise for targeted career development
