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New Commission - Priorities

"Ensure that Europe has the supply of affordable medicines to meet its needs and support Member States in improving the quality and sustainability of their health systems" (Mission letter to Commissioner-Designate Kyriakides)

- Affordability of medicines and health system sustainability
- Fighting shortages of medicines by ensuring access to innovative medicines and actual availability of marketed medicines
- Ensure legislation is future looking and flexible enough to reap the benefits of digitalisation
- Ensure oversight of the global manufacturing supply chain while addressing security challenges
- AMR
- Communication on vaccination
- Cancer Action Plan
