Time and setting to develop data standards

Framework for data standards (e.g. CDISC)

Cash and in-kind contributions

Realistic studies with clear characteristics

Contributions to study design at an early stage

Mandate (scope of work)

Motivation: assurance that investment will yield useful results

Meetings (rooms and travel / subsistence)

Pre-competitive space (preferably formal public-private
partnership)

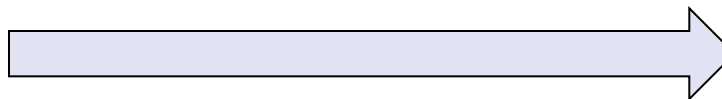
