- A European-wide infrastructure
- Modernise the regulatory framework

- Security and accountability
- Transparency



Opportunities

- Identify areas of (people's) unmet need
- Conduct more targeted clinical trials
 - Patient selection
 - High impact but lower cost
- Improve access to safe and effective innovations
- Ensure monitoring of efficacy and safety of new treatments
- Conduct trials on repurposing medicines



Risks

- Technology-/industry-driven vs patientcentred research and innovation
- Privacy and data security concerns
- Unequal digital literacy
- Lack of personal motivation
- Accessibility inequalities
