Urgently needed as many market initiatives starting

We see a rapid development of surveillance systems of antimicrobial use, both on the level of sales data (as by ESVAC) as on the level of consumption or prescription data.

Eg. QS – Germany, Belgium, Netherlands, Denmark, ...

Harmonisation needed of these <u>national</u> <u>antimicrobial use</u> surveillance programs, as done via ESVAC and also promoted by OIE.





But also, stay cautious!Careful consideration of interpretation

- Comparison is very difficult as:
 - Different species, subspecies kept
 - Different disease situation
 - Different structuring market
 - Different treatment options
- FVE recognises benchmarking can be an important component of antimicrobial stewardship program, but care needs to be taken that the comparison is done with valid, usage data which are, risk-adjusted to account for farm, disease and climate differences.

"Comparison must be done in a fair and responsible way."





FVE comments on **ESVAC** action

- Welcomes action plan
- Keep protocols as simple and practical as possible, avoid double input!
- Work in collaboration, all parties must be convinced of need to avoid black market
- Ensure that all antimicrobials are measured:
 - Also off-label use, medicated feed, topical treatments, all different distributions channels including internet trade
- Please also involve the national veterinary associations of the volunteer MSs.
- FVE welcomes further consultations
