# What matters most for patients and healthcare professionals

- **AI tools improving patient information and empowerment**

- LUPUS GPT:

- Co-created by patient organisations and clinicians to provide accurate, empathetic, and safe health information in 100 languages.
    - Built on carefully selected medical sources; no personal data stored.
    - Helps patients better understand their condition and treatment options, improving shared decision-making.

- **AI helping match patients to clinical trials**

- TrialGPT:

- Developed to help patients and families find relevant clinical trials more easily. Users upload medical information to receive tailored matches.
    - Simplifies complex trial texts, clarifies inclusion/exclusion criteria, and can even draft an email to trial coordinators.

# Proposed priorities for 2026 Workplan

- International harmonisation: advance global regulatory convergence (e.g., EMA–FDA collaboration on Good AI Practice).
- Regulatory guidance: accelerate development of clear, transparent guidance for AI developers and users.
- Regulatory sandboxes: explore AI sandboxes to safely test innovative solutions under regulatory oversight.
