- Governing body of Enpr-EMA
- Discussing and solving operational and scientific issues for the network
- Contributing to short and long-term strategy of Enpr-EMA

CG membership

- Number of seats limited (20 (+4), including networks and key stakeholders)
- Many new networks eligible for CG membership (i.e. Cat. 1)
- → We are launching a call for expression of interest/application to join (or to renew membership in) CG to ensure sufficient renewal and involvement of various individuals

Renewal of the Coordinating Group



- CG membership is for individuals and for a 3-year term
- Last CG renewal in 2018 1 term has been bypassed (2021-2024) without proactive renewal
- Membership can be renewed for more than one term if replacement cannot be nominated and it is not objected by the CG.
- After 2 full terms, a new network representative should be proposed to ensure sufficient renewal and involvement of various individuals.
- Some GC members not involved in the GC meetings

What has happened since 2018?



10-2019: New CG Chair + Co-Chair

01-2020: COVID-19 Pandemic -> only virtual CG and networks meetings

02-2020: UK Brexit -> effects on WGs and CG composition -> UK networks excluded

01-2021: Membership Category simplification -> from 4 to 3 categories

06-2021: The CTIS + CTR development -> applied 01-2022 -> IT fixing ongoing

02-2023: The Enpr-EMA Membership Application Form discussion and consultation by members \rightarrow

03-2024: Revision of Enpr-EMA Membership Application Form -> publication delay on Enpr-EMA website by EMA due to other more critical IT-activities

Basic requirements to apply CG membership



- Current Category 1 networks any Cat 1. network can apply
- Current Category 2 networks -> can apply to be Category 1 network (updated self-assessment)-> eligible to apply for CG membership
- **Networks may have to group themselves** to be represented ("special interest groups") once the maximum number as per composition criteria of the CG has been reached.
- Special interest groups should identify a representative best able to represent their views

Selection criteria by CG mandate



- 1. Category 1 network
- 2. Located in EU or EEA
- 3. Prioritisation of applicants who have never been in CG / new Cat. 1 networks (Sufficient renewal and involvement of various individuals while ensuring continuity)

And,

If there are more than the agreed numbers per composition criteria and no proposal for grouping can be obtained, appointment to the CG will be made by the Chair and two EMA staff representatives using the following criteria:

- 4. Balance of skills and expertise within the respective category
- 5. Level of participation in Enpr-EMA over the past year
- 6. National and/or regional balance of the CG

Tasks of Enpr-EMA CG



Role and tasks of CG members

- Identification of priority actions and tasks of Enpr-EMA
- Approval and oversight of Enpr-EMA's work and activities
- Adjudicator in case of complaints in the context of Enpr-EMA
- Review of Enpr-EMA's working model and working group structure
- Championing and promoting Enpr-EMA

Of note:

- 3 CG meetings per year
- Enpr-EMA CG chair to be elected by and from amongst its members (at annual meeting 2025)
 - → We are relaunching a call for expression of interest/application to join CG

Call for applications for CG membership



Expression of interest/application for CG membership

- Representatives of <u>Category 1 member networks</u>
- Send <u>expression of interest/application</u> to Enpr-EMA secretariat (enprema@ema.europa.eu) <u>by 30th November 2024</u>
 - Brief resumé (cv), including outline of your motivation (≤400 words)
 - Updated self-assessment form, if latest one was submitted in 2022 or before
- Enpr-EMA Sec will assess applications in December/January
- Announcement of new CG in Feb 2025 in writing, first meeting in Mar 2025
- 3-year term (2025-2028, unless earlier renewal due to new legislation)

Note: A separate call for patient and healthcare professionals and industry representatives, as well as PDCO representatives, as CG members & observers, will be launched by EMA's stakeholder department and committee secretariat.
