EUREC is a network

that brings together already existing national Research Ethics Committees (RECs) associations,

networks or comparable initiatives on the European level.

The network promotes capacity building and assistance for local RECs to cooperate in the European Research Area.

EUREC does and could do...

- EUREC-EnprEMA collaboration;
- Survey on several questions regarding RECS's views;
- Participation in meetings;

- > Work on a closer collaboration and communication with stakeholders and RECs;
- > Useful channel to disseminate knowledge and expertise;
- Develop Training Bootcamps for RECs' members.

Understand PDCO's requirements and communicate with RECs

- More active role in informing requirements and guidelines; improve dissemination of knowledge from PDCO;
 - ⇒ Discussion (and training) of RECs' members
- More communication between PDCO's representatives of the CA of each European country;
- Inclusion of national and international associations of RECs;
- **Pro-active communication with** patient representatives and health professionals.

Nevertheless

- RECs are independent in evaluating the trials;
 - ✓ disagreement is possible; there is and should be room for disagreement
- PDCO's requirements are an advice to the legally competent REC; should not be mandatory for RECs;
- RECs´ disagreement should be explained.
 - ➤ Work in collaboration to develop common plans for new drugs and protocols and to protect the best interests of minors.

Suggestions for the Future

- Develop and implement national and European standards whenever possible
- Develop paediatric expertise and a fully aware of all PDCO requirements,
 EMA guidelines and all other paediatric research recommendations
 - > Develop common understanding and improve competences of REC's members by training activities.
- Expand children/adolescents' pilot projects in designing consent forms and recruiting materials
- **EUREC** EnprEMA as a platform for discussion and/or advice
