What is ICMRA

ICMRA is a coalition of leaders of medicines regulatory authorities that provides:

- Strategic directions for enhanced cooperation on common scientific, regulatory or safety challenges
- Improved communication and information sharing
- Effective global crisis response mechanisms











Why ICMRA

- Pharmaceutical research, development, manufacturing and distribution supply chains are complex, multi-faceted and globally integrated.
- The range and diversity of international regulatory initiatives lack integration and call for increased efficiency and strategic oversight.





Addressing global threats to public health

- Vaccines are a cornerstone of health systems globally.
- However, many people are still hesitant to immunise themselves or their children.
- Vaccine hesitancy is one of the main global threats to public health.
- Promoting vaccine confidence is a priority for ICMRA.






Working together to enhance vaccine confidence

Global regulators have developed two joint ICMRA statements for healthcare professionals and the general public.

They aim to:

- ✓ Highlight importance, safety and effectiveness of vaccines
- ✓ Reiterate that it's everyone's responsibility to get vaccinated
- Explain robust processes for evaluation and safety monitoring of vaccines
