

Overview of areas for collaboration and Prioritisation

HMA Veterinary Taskforce
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Monitoring sales of antimicrobials

EMA/ESVAC/ Industry/	Collection and reporting of sales data from across the EU in a uniform way
EMA/ESVAC	Develop/agree common units of measurement of use with others (e.g. USA)
EMA/ESVAC	Share experiences on collection and interpretation with others (e.g. USA)

Understanding prescribing habits

EMA/ HMA / FVE	Developing together a questionnaire for vets across the EU to better understand prescribing habits
EMA/ HMA / FVE	Analysing the questionnaire data and identify the area where greatest leverage can be placed to modify prescribing habits

Surveillance for resistance

HMA/ Industry	Developing more co-ordinated EU programmes for surveillance of target animal pathogens, sharing findings, considering their significance
EMA/HMA/ Industry/Vets	Encouraging reporting of suspected lack of efficacy of antimicrobials

Marketing Authorisations for antimicrobials

CVMP/EMA/HMA (+CMDv)/Industry	Harmonisation of SPCs for <u>certain</u> antimicrobial veterinary medicines + prioritisation
EMA/HMA/ Industry	Implementation of Commission Decisions e.g. Adding warnings relating to prudent use
CVMP/EMA/HMA/ Industry	Ensure revised EU legislation so that the development of new antimicrobials and improved formulations of old but effective antimicrobials are worthwhile
CVMP/EMA/HMA/ Industry/Vets	Identifying and encouraging the availability of the right authorised antimicrobials
CVMP/EMA/HMA/ Industry	Consider innovative solutions e.g. Monographs
Industry (IFAH/EGVVP)	Consider pooling of available data
Academia/CVMP/ Industry	Exploring the use of PK/PD modelling to optimise dose for antimicrobials

Communication with Stakeholders

EMA/ EPRUMA / HMA	Co-ordinated, consistent communication to a range of stakeholders
COPA- COGECA /EPRUMA /HMA/Industry	Co-ordinated, consistent communication to farmers through a shared communication strategy

Education (prescribers/animal owners)

HMA/ EPRUMA / Industry/Vets	Provide clear training materials highlighting what responsible use is and why it is important. Helping with the delivery of training.
COPA- COGECA /EPRUMA /Industry	Provide information to farmers on measures which can reduce the need for antimicrobials (disease prevention)

Other

EMA/HMA	Encourage and follow appropriate developments in the area of antimicrobials for <u>human</u> use
Academia/ Industry/ CVMP (SAGAM)	Review literature and perform risk analysis re gene transfer
ALL	Ensure the revisions to the legislation (veterinary medicines, medicated feed, Animal Health) strike the correct balance
