ICPerMed – An International Consortium

- ➤ Coordination & Support Action, funded by the European Commission to promote personalised medicine
- Started in 2016 and will continue until 2023 and beyond
- ➤ Almost 50 European and international partners
- ➤ Members include public and private `not-for-profit` health research funding and policy organisations and the European Commission

Overall aim: To coordinate and promote **research** along the full value chain to develop and evaluate personalised medicine approaches



Progressed followed by 5 Action Item Groups




ICPerMed Vision Paper

Personalised medicine is developing rapidly!

Genomic Medicine Sweden

The Genomic Medicine Sweden (GMS) initiative aims to contribute to personalised medicine and improved healthcare across Sweden. This will be accomplished through the implementation of large-scale sequencing techniques within healthcare. As new technologies mature, the aim is also to include other omics technologies to provide next-generation diagnostics in healthcare.

Pharmacogenetic Recommendations for Personalised Medicine

In this study published in <u>Genetics in Medicine</u>, a team of geneticists and bioinformaticians around Dr. Lili Milani at the University of Tartu developed and tested algorithms for translation of preexisting genotype data of over 44,000 participants of the Estonian biobank into pharmacogenetic recommendations.

Personalised medicine in action: How the adoption of electronic medical records (EMR) is supporting a personalised "taking care" approach and the development of predictive algorithms


Since the early 2000's the hospital of Vimercate, a town of approx. 25,000 inhabitants close to Milan, has implemented the Electronic Medical Records (EMR). The application of EMR was triggered by three major needs:

Genomic medicine is profoundly changing patient care. Routine genome sequencing will enable a high number of patients to benefit from more personalised diagnostics and **personalised therapeutic care**. This includes rare diseases and cancer but also more common diseases (e.g. metabolic, cardiovascular, neurological diseases).




- Mapping Activity: Ongoing funding programmes in Personalised Medicine

ICPerMed State of the Art Report




- Available on ICPerMed Website

European Partnership on Personalised Medicine (EP PerMed)

- One of the new partnerships under the Horizon Europe framework is proposed to be dedicated to personalised medicine (EP PerMed)
- As a consequence, representatives from ICPerMed and ERA Permed prepared a draft concept paper describing how EP PerMed could look based on the two organisations's experiences from the last five years
- This concept paper is now available and will be used by the European Commission in the upcoming Member States consultations
