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Background

-  Availability issues: complex and diverse causes affecting all stakeholders
Leading to: Patients suffering disruption of treatment
-  Coordinated actions from all stakeholders needed.
-  Task Force aims:
 - to enhance visibility of existing tools and procedures to manage availability problems.
 - to improve access to information on availability, and to establish a dialogue with patients and healthcare professionals and animal owners, to improve communication and get input on availability problems.



Previous workshops raised awareness of problem and identified areas for common work.
