Explore and involve

- Explore the nurses added value and collect examples
- Include nurses in monitoring overuse and misuse
- Explore if nurses can act according to prudent use of AB
- Involve nurses with prescribing authority
- Facilitate nurses in patient health literacy on AMR



Field to include nurses

- Education and training congruent / consistent with HCP and NGO's
- Add AMR in nurses curricula and competency frameworks
- Design programs: awareness, health literacy, prevention and AMR steward programs
- Explore relevance for a specific Guideline on AMR for nurses



Nurse Stewardship and Advocacy

- Multi stakeholders approach: EMA, ECDC and DG's
- Health institutes, Regulatory bodies, NNA's and European colleague NGO's
- Target is include nurses systematically: local and national.
 - Avoid tendency to regard nursing professional as homogeneous group
 - Focus on higher educated and advanced educated levels.
- ESNO foreseen activities*
 - Raise awareness to its members: constuancies and social media
 - Form a ESNO Focus group on AMR
 - Explore relevance for **'AMR-Prevention and Controle Guideline for Nurses'**
