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Why ePI?

Article 59(4) Directive 2001/83/EC

By 1 January 2013, the Commission shall present to the European Parliament and the Council an assessment report on current short-comings in the summary of product characteristics and the package leaflet and how they could be improved in order to better meet the needs of patients and healthcare professionals. The Commission shall, if appropriate, and on the basis of the report, and consultation with appropriate stakeholders, present proposals in order to improve the readability, layout and content of these documents.

"[...] an assessment report on current shortcomings in the summary of product characteristics and the package leaflet and how they could be improved in order to better meet the needs of patients and healthcare professionals."

Two external study reports – NIVEL and University of Leeds

- "PIL-S study" current shortcomings in the leaflets of medicinal products for human use
- 2. "PILS-BOX study" feasibility and value of a possible insertion of "key information section"

Consultation of Member States

- · Summarised in the background document
- Published on the Commission website, together with the external study reports









Why ePI? - EU initiatives on PI

EC report on PI

- Adopted and published on 22 March 2017
- · Number of recommendations identified
- Scope for improvement within the boundaries of existing legislation



COM(2017) 135 final REPORT FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND THE COUNCIL

in accordance with Article 59(4) of Directive 2001/83/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 6 November 2001 on the Community code relating to medicinal products for human use

ePI formats:

- e-formats bring new opportunities
- Potential benefits in developing key principles [...] to provide the information to individual EU citizens
- e-formats should be complementary to paper PL [...] to ensure availability of the information to all patients

EMA action plan

- Developed and adopted in Q4 2017
- Identified concrete deliverables and timelines
- ePI was given the highest priority (implementation started in 2017)

EC/EMA/HMA joint collaboration:

- · Mapping current digital initiatives in EU
- Multi-stakeholder workshop on ePI
- Develop key principles for the use of ePI












eHealth Digital Service Infrastructure for cross-border exchange of health data




