He is currently Head of Medical Assessors at the Pharmaceutical Inspectorate of the Belgian Ministry of Public Health. He is also Head of the Clinical Unit for Nutrition and Pharmaco-dynamics at the Queen Fabiola Children's University Hospital, Brussels and Professor of nutrition and related diseases at the Free University of Brussels. He was first appointed a member of the CPMP in 1997 and elected as chairman in January 2001.
- 2. Eric Abadie (French) is a physician specialised in internal medicine, endocrinology, diabetology and cardiology. He is currently Director of Pharmaco-Therapeutic Evaluation at the Agence française de sécurité sanitaire des produits de santé (AFSSAPS).
