Organisational matters

CHMP meeting 24-27 June 2013

The Committee welcomed Jana Klimasova as new CHMP alternate member for Slovakia who replaced Vlasta Kakosova and Melinda Sobor as new CHMP alternate member for Hungary who replaced Janos Borvendeg in this role.

The main organisational topics addressed during the June 2013 CHMP meeting related to:

- The appointment of Harald Enzmann and Concepcion Prieto Yerro as CHMP representatives to the European Medicines Agency Human Scientific Committees' Working Party with Patients' and Consumers' Organisations (PCWP).
- The endorsement of Melinda Sobor (Hungary) as CHMP representative (alternate) to the PDCO.
- The appointment of new Working Party members from Croatia:
 - Koraljka Mestrovic as a new QWP member
 - Maja Tabak Slosic as a new QWP alternate
 - Tamara Mandusic Nazor as a new BWP member
 - Dijana Lovrecki as a new BWP alternate
 - Vesna Osrecki as a new BPWP member
- A presentation and discussion on the revision of the World Medical Association Declaration of Helsinki.
- The agreement on the areas of expertise for the two CHMP co-opted members to be elected at the July 2013 CHMP Plenary meeting. The CHMP members noted that the 3 year term of the co-opted members Sol Ruiz and Jean-Louis Robert is coming to an end on 19 July 2013. The Committee agreed on the complementary expertise in addition to the available expertise in the CHMP as Quality (non-biologicals) (Synthetic chemicals) and Quality (biotech and biological), with expertise in advanced therapies (gene, cell and tissue therapies). A call for nominations will follow with the election of the two co-opted members scheduled at the July 2013 Plenary meeting.
