Dr Vassilios Papadakis was born on 6/6/1996 and was brought up in Pireaus, Greece. He graduated Ionidios Lyceum with honors, first in order in 1979 and enrolled the Medical School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens eight in order. He obtained his MD degree with summa cum laude in 1/1986, following elective training in the summer of 1985 in Pediatric Gastroenterology in the USA Professor Lebenthal, Buffalo, NY).

Residency in Pediatrics (1987-1990) was completed at St Luke's / Roosevelt Medical Center of the Columbia University of Physicians and Surgeons (New York City, USA). Full Fellowship in Pediatric Hematology- Oncology was completed at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center and NYH Cornell Medical Center (1990-1993, NYC).
