EU co-funding and exceptional utility: action grants

- As a rule: EU co-funding up to **max 60%** of eligible costs.
- Exceptionally: EU co-funding up to **max 80%** for actions with a clear EU added value which satisfy the following exceptional utility criteria, inter alia, when:

(a) at least 30% of the budget of the proposed action is allocated to Member States whose GNI per inhabitant is less than 90% of the Union average*;

(b) bodies from at least 14 participating Member States participate in the action, of which at least four are Member States whose GNI per inhabitant is less than 90% of the Union average.

* Please consult the [Gross National Income \(GNI\) table per capita per Member States](#) and the 90% of the Union average valid for the 2024 programme.

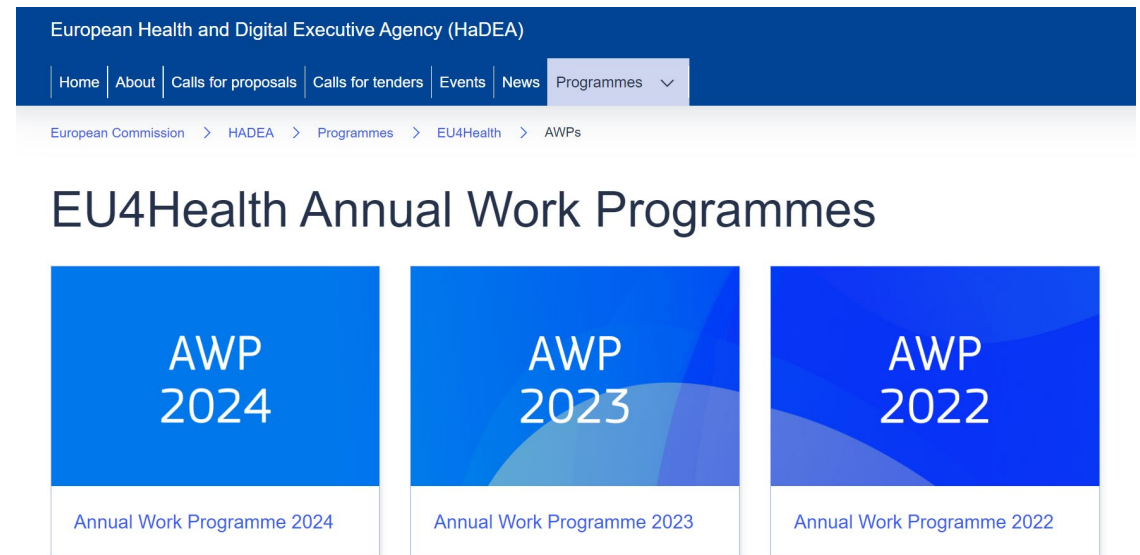


Annual EU4Health Work Programmes
