HYPERMARKER	01.01.2023- 31.12.2027	HYPERMARKER aims to improve the treatment of hypertension. The project uses health information and data to identify why different patients respond differently to these different responses will be used to identify the best medication for each patient (treatment. To test this tool, the project is currently being implemented in Spain, Netherlands, and Germany). The project's use of deep learning and exposomic data is uncovering novel patterns that have not been previously documented. These findings show that hypertension is treated by enabling more personalized care to individual patients. Key to the project's success will be early results. This includes additional research, clinical trials, and the development of new diagnostics emerging from the project.
