



Amendment of policy on transparency and handling of potential conflicts of interests

5.2. Steps for the operation of the policy

Submission of a declaration of interests

At the beginning of their mandate and once yearly, all members of the Coordinating Group ~~and working groups~~ shall submit their declaration of interests and include additional information on research interests. In case of new interests, an updated form must be submitted.

The names of the members of Enpr-EMA coordinating group ~~and working groups~~, and their declarations of interests will be published on the Agency's website.

Inclusion in the Agency's Expert Database

All members of Enpr-EMA coordinating group ~~and its working groups~~ shall be included in the Agency's experts' database.

Inclusion on the Agency's experts' database should take place prior to any involvement in activities of Enpr-EMA. Such inclusion requires that the following documents be submitted to the Agency:

- Public declaration of interests and confidentiality undertaking form, and
- Curriculum Vitae.

Once these documents are forwarded to the agency the Enpr-EMA Secretariat will notify the Agency's Executive Director before confirming the appointment with the respective Enpr-EMA member.



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- CG Working Group members no longer obliged to submit their declaration of interests
- CG members no longer obliged to include additional information on research interests
- CG Working Group members no longer included in the Experts Database
